Twelve States Where Concealed Guns are allowed by Law

	There states where conceated cans are another by Law	
Arkansas:	Faculty, staff, students and visitors with an "enhanced" permit may carry on state campuses including	
	places like Greek housing, dorms, libraries, faculty offices, and classrooms. The "enhanced" permit	
	includes an eight hour training course on active shooting situations.	
Colorado:	Concealed guns on campus are allowed by law. Only buildings that are under contractual agreement	
	with outside companies may be excluded from the law.	
Georgia:	Individuals 21 or older possessing a Georgia concealed carry license may, as well as licenses issued by	
	other states recognized in Georgia, carry a concealed weapon on a public college or university campus in	
	Georgia. Concealed weapons are prohibited in university housing, athletic events, Greek housing, faculty	
	offices, areas where K-12 education occurs, and disciplinary hearings.	
Idaho:	Individuals who possess an "enhanced" carry permit may carry weapons on campus, however,	
	concealed and openly carried firearms are prohibited in dorms, and buildings and functions housing	
	more than 1,000 individuals.	
Kansas:	Concealed guns are permitted on campus except where "adequate security measures" are provided.	
Mississippi:	Individuals with an "enhanced" concealed carry license may carry concealed weapons on campus.	
Ohio:	Beginning March 1, 2017, all public colleges and universities have the discretion to decide whether to

	allow concealed handguns on campus. Concealed weapons are currently permitted in locked cars in	
	parking lots.	
Oregon:	Schools cannot ban weapons on the physical grounds of a campus, however, they may permit concealed	
	handguns inside of buildings. As of 2017, no public school permits guns inside of buildings.	
Tennessee:	Full time faculty and staff who hold a concealed carry permit may carry concealed handguns on campus	
	once registering with campus law enforcement. Students are excluded from this law.	
Texas:	Individuals who have a license to carry may carry their concealed weapons on campus. Schools may	
	prohibit guns in certain sensitive areas on campus.	
Utah:	Concealed guns on campus are allowed by law.	
Wisconsin:	Concealed weapons are allowed on campus, however, schools may prohibit them in buildings by posting
